



Throughout his life, Ryan gave where he saw the need, and rallied others to do the same.

By the age of 9, he raised money for the Pediatric Specialty Clinic at Yale by selling self-made books and putting on one-man Disney-movie plays in his garage. A backyard fair raised over \$1600 for the Wallingford Homeless Shelter.

In 8th grade, Ryan received his school's Community Service Award for his efforts in raising funds for Cystic Fibrosis, efforts which he continued through the end of his high school years. And posthumously, Cystic Fibrosis gave him their Hero Award for his fundraising and volunteer efforts.

At the tender age of 19, Ryan lost his life to a very aggressive cancer.

A week before his death, and in keeping with his life-long spirit of giving, Ryan asked that \$70,000 of his unused college funds be donated to charities that were important to him, and he hoped his donations would inspire others to do the same after he was gone.

Ryan's legacy is now a fund at The Community Foundation of Middlesex County

(CFMC is a 501(c)(3) organization) called Ryan's Circle of Giving (RCG). Since 2006, over \$456,000 has been raised bringing the total of funds raised in Ryan's name to \$526,000.
